The Energy Summit Attendee Policies

The Energy Summit is the annual conference of the Colorado Oil & Gas Association (COGA). As a condition of attending the 2019 Energy Summit, any Attendee (including, but not limited to a registered attendee, guest, sponsor, speaker, student, staff or volunteer) participating in the Energy Summit agrees to adhere to the following terms and conditions.

Refund Policy for Conference Registrations

All Energy Summit registration sales are final and nonrefundable as of July 1, 2019. A 2019 Energy Summit registration may be transferred to another individual, provided individual qualifies for the type of registration being transferred. Transfer requests must be made by August 26, 2019.

Rules, Regulations, & Attendee Conduct

Attendee agrees to abide by all fire, safety, and health regulations of the local, city, state, conference hotels, and conference venue(s) where The Energy Summit is held. Attendee must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local ordinances, as well as The Energy Summit policies and procedures as set forth below.

Participants who violate such rules and/or who behave in an unsafe or careless manner while attending The Energy Summit may be asked to leave immediately and will be held responsible for their actions. The Attendee acknowledges that such violations may result in the Attendee being removed from The Energy Summit and barred from returning without refund of the Attendee's registration fee(s).

The Attendee likewise acknowledges and agrees that all attendees of The Energy Summit have the right to enjoy The Energy Summit equally. Illegal or disruptive behavior that interferes with the conduct of reasonable business at The Energy Summit, or any other attendee's safety or comfort, including behavior that impedes or prevents the professional and respectful participation in the conference for others is strictly prohibited and may result in the Attendee being removed from The Energy Summit and barred from returning without refund of the Attendee's registration fee(s). Such violations may be reported to legal authorities. If you witness a crime or have an emergency that requires the police, please call 911.

Accessibility Services

COGA is committed to making all reasonable arrangements that will allow attendees to participate in The Energy Summit events. To best serve conference attendees and secure necessary equipment, attendees who require onsite assistance and accommodation during The Energy Summit should make any requests in advance to COGA.

Conference Venue

Attendees of The Energy Summit are required to comply with all alcohol and drug policies set forth by the conference venue(s). Smoking is not permitted in conference venue(s) and is permitted in areas designated by the conference venue(s) only.

Lost Registration Badge

Attendee's registration badge must be worn at all times during The Energy Summit. Access to the conference facilities will not be granted to those without proper credentials. Due to limited capacity at ticketed events (including, but not limited to the luncheons and Opening Night Party), lost and/or stolen event tickets cannot be replaced, and refunds will not be issued for lost and/or stolen tickets. Replacement of registration badges can be obtained with proper photo ID at the conference registration check-in counters.

No Solicitations

The Colorado Oil & Gas Association (COGA) maintains a no-solicitation policy covering all of its conferences, meetings, webinars and other events. In order to provide a distraction-free environment for our members and other attendees, solicitation of any kind during any event, including asking for business or soliciting services is prohibited without the express written permission of COGA. Examples of prohibited solicitation activity include, but are not limited to:

- Unauthorized promotion of non-COGA events
- Unauthorized on-site distribution of printed or electronic materials including literature, signs, flyers, invitations, tickets, forms, etc. (except business cards)

Any person and/or organization found to be violating this policy may be removed from the event without refund of registration fees. Egregious and/or multiple violations of this policy may result in disqualification from future events at the discretion of COGA.
