CODE OF CONDUCT

Industry Integrity

- Hold contractors and employees accountable to this code of conduct
- Encourage an industry and company culture that values environmental protection and community engagement as priorities

Environmental Protection

- Value the integrity of the landscape, water, air, and wildlife resources
- Pledge to conduct our operations in an environmentally responsible manner
- Support strong and reasonable regulatory framework consistent with public health, safety, welfare, and the protection of the environment
- Recognize the unique character of each site and that our operations need to be managed to minimize conflict with competing land uses

Community Engagement

- Value the interests of landowners, consumers, and local communities
- Cooperate with local governing entities to address the concerns of local jurisdictions and their citizens
- Understand the need of local residents to contact operators and provide easy to access contact information
- Communicate plans and actions in which local groups or individuals may have an interest
- Respond promptly to the concerns voiced by local and regional stakeholders
