Updated Guidance for In-Person Energy Summit Attendees:

Given Colorado's rising rate of COVID-19 infections, and our commitment to your safety and well-being, we ask that all non-vaccinated guests receive a negative COVID-19 test 24 hours prior to attending the Energy Summit on August 24. In addition, we are encouraging Energy Summit attendees to wear a mask while indoors at our in-person conference. We are following the guidance of the City and County of Denver, and the Denver Museum of Nature and Science, and neither, at this time, believe the health risk is great enough to institute a mandatory policy for mask wearing. However, given concern over the Delta variant we are encouraging mask use indoors, especially in areas where it might be difficult to social distance, such as our session space. Our evening reception is expected to be held outdoors, depending on the weather. We are committed to prioritizing the health of our community, and look forward to welcoming you to our Energy Summit next week.

Should public health orders, or policies with our venue change, COGA will notify attendees promptly and update this document to reflect any changes.
